

This natural reservation hosts the **largest wetlands in Europe**, its unspoiled backwaters offer the unique opportunity to observe the incredible beauty of the Danube Delta landscapes and all the treasures lying in it: 45 freshwater fish species, **fishermens' heaven**; the ideal place for 300 migratory & year-round birds, a density unmatched anywhere else in the world, therefore a **birdwatchers' paradise**.

#### **Transylvania:** *The Hidden Treasure Of Prince Charles*

Transylvania, “**the land beyond the forest**”, one of Europe’s hidden treasures is by far the most magical, fascinating of Romania’s historical provinces. Snow-capped mountain peaks, dense forests sheltering abundant wildlife, legendary castles, fairytale-like villages, sparkling streams, caves, wooden churches & lowland valleys altogether reveal a land rich in **history** and natural beauty.

## Cluj-Napoca

Group pick up from Cluj-Napoca Airport.

**Cluj-Napoca**, the former capital of Transylvania is today one of Romania's most vibrant and dynamic cities. City tour with the visit of St. Michael's Gothic Church, the Benedictine Monastery, the Museum Square, the Unification Square.

The capital of Transylvania in the medieval times, Cluj-Napoca is sharing nowadays, both traditional and progressive events.

## Cluj-Napoca - Sighișoara - Viscri - Brașov

Leaving Cluj-Napoca for **Sighișoara**, UNESCO World Heritage listed is a small fortified city in the heart of Transylvania. Visit of the well preserved fortified site: Stag House, Clock Tower, Church on the Hill, Venetian Gothic House, Covered Stairs.

The tour continues to **Viscri** village. Situated 43 km far from Sighișoara, Viscri hosts a spectacular fortified Saxon church, listed in the UNESCO Cultural Heritage Site and is an oasis of tranquility where Charles, Prince of Wales owns traditional houses.

Transfer to **Brașov**. Short city tour with the visit of the City Council Square, the Black Church (one of Brașov's landmarks), Ecaterina's gate, a fairy-looking medieval tower, part of the last preserved original city gates.

Dinner and accommodation in **Brașov/Poiana Brașov**.

DAY 03

## Brașov - Sinaia - Bran - Brașov

Transfer to **Sinaia** mountain resort, the "Pearl of the Carpathians". Visit of the **Peleș Castle**: former residence of Romania's Kings, built by King Carol I of Romania as his summer residence, which shelters an important collection of art works, rare furniture and valuable paintings.

Lunch and wine tasting (sparkling wines produced using the traditional method) in the "**Rhein Azuga**" wine cellars, former supplier of the Romanian Royal Court.

In the afternoon - visit of the **Bran Castle**, known as the Dracula's Castle. The medieval stronghold perched on rocks high above the valley was built in the XIV<sup>th</sup> century, in order to protect the peasants and landowners at the border between the two historical provinces: Walachia and Transylvania.

Traditional dinner and accommodation in **Brașov/Poiana Brașov**.

DAY 04

## Brașov - Sâmbăta - Sibiu (former European Capital of Culture)

Transfer to **Sâmbăta de Sus**. Visit of the Sâmbăta Monastery ("Brâncoveanu" Monastery) a place of recovery, comfort and spirituality, built on Constantin Brâncoveanu's order in an original Romanian style, in XVII<sup>th</sup> century. The route between Brașov and Sibiu follows the majestic Făgăraș mountains ridge, the highest mountains in Romania; crossing several villages typical for Transylvania.

In the afternoon, the tour of the medieval centre of **Sibiu**, one of Romania's most attractive cities: the **Large Square** with Brukenthal Palace, Haller House, the Catholic Church and the Council Tower - landmark of the city, the **Small Square** with Luxembourg House, the Liar's Bridge, the House of Arts, and the **Huet Square** with the Evangelical Church, the Cetății/Fortress Street.

## Sibiu Outskirts

Visit the town **Cisnădie** (Heltau in German, 10 km far from Sibiu), with its Saxon fortified church St. Walpurga (XIII<sup>th</sup> century), and then **Cisnădioara** (Michelsberg in German), with the Roman Catholic church, representative monument for the Romanesque architecture in Transylvania.

In the afternoon, get acquainted with the traditional folk architecture and popular techniques exposed in the picturesque "**ASTRA**" open air Museum, located in the forest of Dumbrava Sibiului.

Dinner with traditional menu and folk show in a rural pension, in **Sibiul** (22 km from Sibiu) - Glass Icons Museum unique in Europe, over 700 exhibits.

## Sibiu - Alba Iulia - Turda - Cluj-Napoca

Transfer to **Alba Iulia**.

Short city tour with the visit of Alba Carolina Fortress (Guard Changing Ceremony - every day at 12 pm), the Roman Catholic Church, the Reunification Cathedral.

**Alba Iulia**'s landmark is represented by the **Vauban-style fortress** with seven bastions, star shaped.

Next stop: **Turda**. Visit of the **Turda Salt Mine**, one of the oldest and most important salt mines in Transylvania, dating from the XVII<sup>th</sup> century; re-arranged and displaying for the tourists old shafts, health and recreational facilities.

Dinner and accommodation **Cluj-Napoca**.

Discover the highlights of **Sibiu**, with its picture-perfect medieval Old Town and its surroundings.

**Sibiu** is ranked on the 8<sup>th</sup> place in Europe's Top 10 Most Idyllic Places To Live (Forbes Magazine) and it is a perfect destination for a relaxed city break within its fascinating historical landmarks, vibrant cultural life and surrounded by its friendly people.

### Sibiu: Cultural and Ethnic Diversity

Group pick up from **Sibiu** Airport, transfer to the hotel.

**Sibiu** is one of Romania's most charming cities, elected in **2007** as the **European Capital of Culture**, together with the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

Pedestrian city tour of the medieval centre of **Sibiu**: **Large Square** (Brukenthal Palace, Haller House, Catholic Church and Council Tower – one of the city's landmarks); **Small Square** (Luxembourg House, Liar's Bridge, House of Arts); **Huet Square** (Evangelical Church and its tiny colourful houses, some built in the XII<sup>th</sup> century); and **Strada Cetății** (Fortress Street) with the Guilds Defense Towers and cozy cafes.

## Sibiu Outskirts: Hike or Bike

**Hike:** Visit the town **Cisnădie** (German: Heltau, 10 km far from Sibiu), with its Saxon fortified church of St. Walpurga (built in the XIII<sup>th</sup> century, proudly showing **the first lightning rod** ever to be **mounted in Transylvania**). Afterwards a short trip is arranged to **Cisnădioara** (German: Michelsberg), with its Romanesque Basilica, an exquisite architectural monument in Transylvania (1260).

**Bike:** Bikes can be rented for this purpose for those who are interested in exploring by pedaling (not included).

In the afternoon visit of the picturesque **open air "ASTRA" Museum:** the largest in Romania and one of the biggest in Central Europe.

Optional: Enjoy the thrills offered by "Arka Park" in **Păltiniș**, an adventure park located 24 km far from Sibiu or freetime.

## Sibiu, Biertan, Sighișoara: Saxon Heritage

On the way to Sighișoara, the route crosses an area that concentrates a large part of the Saxons heritage: built between the XIII<sup>th</sup> and the XV<sup>th</sup> century by the Saxon settlers, Transylvania is a unique place in the whole world: in such a small region 150 locations with fortified churches or villages defense-churches are to be found, preserved and displayed.

Short visit in **Medias** - St Margareth's church, late Gothic; followed by a visit to the impressive **Biertan** (German: Birthälm) fortified church, former see of the Protestant bishops for 300 years.

Transfer to **Sighișoara**. Visit of the well preserved fortified site, some of its highlights being: Stag House, Clock Tower, Church on the Hill, Venetian-Gothic House, Covered Stairs. Sighișoara (German: Schässburg) is one of Transylvania's gems, one of the most charming cities in the region and the best preserved medieval citadel in Romania. Prince Vlad "The Impaler" Dracul, the main source of inspiration for Bram Stoker's Vampire Novel "Dracula" was born here; a visit to his supposedly birthouse in Sighișoara is possible.

Return to **Sibiu**.

Farewell dinner with Saxon menu in "Hermania" restaurant Sibiu, accommodation in **Sibiu**.
